

Training course for dance teachers

The course will consist of five modules, each lasting three hours, and will include, in addition to the theory classes held in the afternoons, the opportunity to attend students' practical classes in the mornings. These sessions will provide an opportunity to observe how each discipline is directly applied to practical work in dance teaching.

The modules to be covered will be:

1._Pointe Methodology

Methodological and pedagogical development of technical and stylistic elements in the learning of pointe work.

2._Pas de Deux Methodology

An Introduction to the Pas de deux Technique: Methodological and Teaching Approaches. Key Technical Elements and Their Progression.

3._Men's Methodology

Methodological and pedagogical development. Specific physical conditioning. Preparation for performance and repertoire. Technical virtuosity in men's technique.

4._Educational Psychology Applied to Dance

Optimising teaching through an understanding of the key psycho-pedagogical principles and models applicable to dance instruction. The teacher-student relationship. Types of students and teaching styles. Effective marking. Correction: what, how, when and why to correct. Group management and dealing with difficult cases.

5._Anatomy and Biomechanics Applied to Dance

Basic concepts of bodywork. Body alignment in dance. L'En-dehors. Biomechanical principles of jumping. Conditions and injuries in dance practice.
